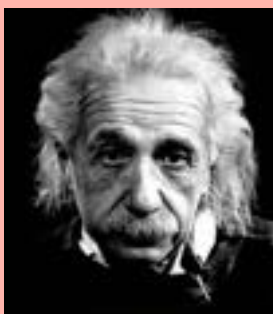
### Skidway Superstars 4-H Spin Club

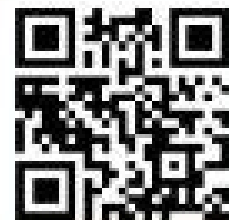
